

Company Position in relation to the Global Coronavirus outbreak

We would like to take this opportunity to re-assure our customers we are monitoring the impact of the recent outbreak of the coronavirus through our supply chain.

In addition to the already increased stock levels at our Wolverhampton distribution centre, MacLellan had planned for significant stocks to be despatched immediately prior to the prolonged Chinese New Year shutdown and these have been arriving over the last few weeks and will continue to arrive into March 2020.

Whilst there has undoubtedly been a longer than expected manufacturing shutdown we have already had confirmation that manufacturing has resumed and have confirmation of containers shipping in the next 10 Days.

MacLellan cannot account for what may well be a market shortage of materials, as we are seeing and do expect there to be increased demand for products.

We will always try to prioritise supplies to our existing loyal customer base, however practically this can be difficult to do.

We would recommend that you speak with our Sales Team to ensure that we are aware of your requirements over the next few weeks and months and you place forward schedules where practicable.

We would also remind you that we have a Global Supply Chain and have an extensive range of European Manufactured Products that often can be more suited to certain applications.

These include our fully certified Food Quality EC1935, Metal Detectable, Chemours Viton's, Drinking Water, Flame Retardant, Wear Resistant, Anti-Static and Electrically Insulative grades.

We continue to work closely with all aspects of our supply chain and will post further updates should the need arise.
