

Declaration of non-use Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals under TSCA Section 6(h)

Under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued five final rules on January 6, 2021 to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are persistent, bio accumulative and toxic (PBT).

Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals
Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)
